In a surprising turn of events, the Maine State Legislature has started holding public hearings and work sessions. As a result, the LPC is being convened to establish positions on a subset of bills that are likely to be heard and worked before the Legislature returns in January to kick off the second session.

Some of the bills on the review list below have been vetted at least once by the policy committee, however, more feedback is needed. Additionally, to effectively explain the membership's position on a variety of "hot button" issues, it is vital that members provide the details staff will rely on to communicate MMA's message to legislators, especially when presenting "neither for nor against" testimony. Because it is anticipated that the process will move very quickly, we need to get our messages across at these hearings.

At Tuesday's meeting staff will also provide updates on the progress being made by established task forces and commissions, as well as an overview of what is in store for next session. Members of the policy committee are urged to review the list of second session bill requests found here, which will be vetted by the Legislative Council when they meet on Thursday, October 26.
