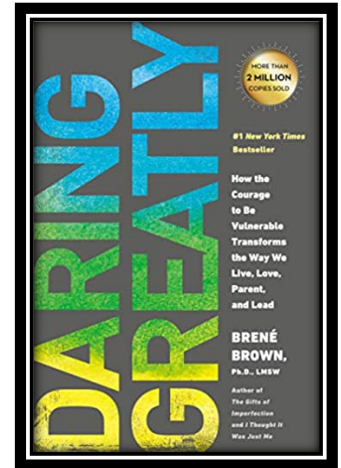

What is an Athenian Dialogue? Athenian Dialogues explore leadership principles and practice, drawing on the insights contained in a book that all participants have read. Dialogues are conversations in which clerks share their experience and understanding as it relates to the ideas of the author and the relevance of those ideas to their public leadership.

About our book: Every day we experience the uncertainty, risks, and emotional exposure that define what it means to be vulnerable or to dare greatly. Brown explains how vulnerability is both the core of difficult emotions like fear, grief and disappointment, *and* the birthplace of love, belonging, joy, empathy, innovation, and creativity.
