

- SUBJECT: Winter-Related Federal & State Surplus Items

With winter on the horizon, we're spotlighting a few surplus items that may be of interest to towns and municipalities in Maine.

Federal Surplus: Caterpillar 924G Front End Loader

Towns can acquire a federal surplus loader for just 1% to 4% of the original cost! You must have a valid donee account (see next page) and complete a short <u>screening form</u> to get started.

Donee Access to Surplus Property

Under the Maine Surplus Property Donee Program, towns and municipalities in Maine are eligible to acquire surplus items that are no longer needed by state departments **at a significantly reduced cost**. Approved donees can also acquire federal surplus property available from the U.S. General Services Administration (GSA).

Step 1: Become a donee

The first step to access state or federal surplus property is to become a donee by completing this <u>Donee Application Form</u>. After your application is approved, your town can purchase any available surplus items up to 30 days before they are offered to the public.

Step 2: After becoming a donee, your town can acquire surplus property in these ways:

• <u>To view and purchase surplus property stored in our warehouse</u> (85 Leighton Road in Augusta), visit in person Monday through Friday between 8:00am – 3:30pm. New items are added to the surplus warehouse every day!

NOTE: Maine Surplus Property has a public sale on the second Friday of every month. The warehouse has the most items available to donees Monday through Thursday during the week of the public sale and will have fewer items directly after the sale on Friday morning.


- <u>To purchase vehicles and larger items stored in the auction yard</u>, attend Donee Viewing & Sale Day on the third Thursday of each month. Donees can view auction yard inventory on the <u>Donee Guidance page</u> of our website; or view items in person beginning at 1:00pm on Donee Viewing Day. These items go on sale for donees at 2:00pm. After this, all items are made available to the public on <u>GovPlanet</u>.
- <u>To view and request federal surplus property</u>, please follow the guidelines posted on our <u>Donee Guidance page</u>.


