

An Act to Direct the Maine Criminal Justice Academy to Develop a Nonresidential Law Enforcement Training Program

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2804-C, sub-§4, ¶B, as amended by PL 2005, c. 331, §22, is further amended to read:

B. Provide a structured residential or nonresidential program that balances the goals of professional policing with public services emphasis; and

Sec. 2. Rulemaking. The Board of Trustees of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy shall adopt rules to develop a nonresidential law enforcement training program in order to increase recruitment. In developing and implementing a nonresidential program, the board shall evaluate the sufficiency of existing staffing levels, develop additional curricula and ensure that training outcomes are maintained.

SUMMARY

This bill requires the Board of Trustees of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy to develop and implement a nonresidential law enforcement training program.
